## IEC meeting on November 28th, 2020, Deptt. of RMDA

The meeting started at 11 A.M. with DCE presentations followed by RMDA Department. The IEC experts had the following observations:

The sample size can be reviewed in studies with large samples as the idea is to teach students how to do research. Data collection should use online modes with minimum personal contact since these are special circumstances.

- 1. Awareness generation regarding solar photo voltaic systems among residents of Burari- Gunjan Yadav
  - Suggestion- How the beneficiaries have benefitted from the awareness generation should be studied and clearly reported.
- 2. Empowering Self-help groups towards online marketing- A study in Delhi NCR- Lalita Rani
  - Basis of selection of 2 SHGs in phase II of the study to be explained in methodology
- 3. Study of emerging work from home trend: Challenges during Covid times-Mahima Agarwal
  - IT professionals have been taken as the sample who even in non covid situations worked from home due to the nature of their job and work culture in IT. Still the study has taken them as the sample.
- 4. An appraisal of physical adaptations by secondary school students to home environment for online learning- Manisha Singh
  - Some case studies can be included in the study to further the objectives
- 5. Impact of covid-19 outbreak on migrant workers in Uttar Pradesh- Simran Sethi
  - There is a disjoint between the title and objectives. Objective 3 is not going with the title. Can be reviewed. Study to be more focused based on the title.
- 6. Empowering stakeholders towards star labeled appliances: a study in Haridwar- Swati Sharma
  - What is the definition of low and middle income group used in the study is not clear
- 7. Online shopping behavior of consumers during covid-19 pandemic: A study in Delhi NCR
  - Composition of the household can be studied to get an idea of the families doing online shopping

8. Impact of skill building initiatives on economic independence among women-Thuanlimlakliu Chawang

Which type of skills the training institutes are imparting- whether they are traditional skills of local communities/tribes or other skills needs to be clearly written

9. Entrepreneurial development for the tribal women of Jharkhand- Vritika Kanwal

Primary data being used is from the Ph.D. study, need to specify whether this study was published or unpublished. Data on households, respondents, villages selected -how is this being collected- needs to be written clearly.
