### All India Women Education Fund Association (AIWEFA)

All India Women's Education Fund (AIWEFA) an 87 year old NGO, founded Lady Irwin College, New Delhi in 1932. All through, AIWEFA has rendered various services to promote holistic and sustainable development for the welfare of communities. AIWEFA's activities promote education and training of women for family and child care, environmental sustainability, health and nutrition, development of rural families through introduction of drudgery reducing equipment for agricultural management, women's skill development, women's political representation and programmes to fight violence against women. Combining academic strength with sound implementation and training strategies, AIWEFA campaigns and mobilises through its field projects, seminars, workshops, publications and networking, to bring about a sustainable approach to human development and advancement of the weaker sections.

AIWEFA was granted the "NGO in Special Consultative Status with the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations (ECOSOC)". In 2003, AIWEFA accepted the role of Regional Coordinator of the UN's Informal Regional Network of NGOs.

AIWEFA members attended the conference organised by AIWC on "Strengthening Women's voices in shaping post 2015 Agenda" on 21 & 22 July 2015, at IIC, New Delhi. Under this project, AIWEFA is continuing to mobilize women having a permanent car driving license for one year to be trained and employed as commercial drivers by OLA Cab Co. for their "cabs by women" scheme.

The XIIIth AIWEFA-Nina Sibal Memorial Award Function was held on 2 August, 2015 at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi. An award comprising a Trophy, citation and a cash prize of Rs 5 Lakhs, is bestowed upon an organization working in the area of disability. About 600 nomination forms were sent out, and from the applications received the "HUMANITY WELFARE ORGANISATION HELPLINE (HWOH)" from Anantnag, Kashmir, was selected for the award. The award was received by the founder of HWOH, Mr. Javed Ahmad Tal on a wheel chair.
