The Internal Complaints Committee is a statutory body instituted with the purpose of prevention of sexual harassment at the workplace. Its functions include:

- Counseling services for complainants
- Consultation/ Support services for colleges
- Sensitization/ Awareness programmes for prevention of sexual harassment at the workplace

- 2 non-teaching staff
- 3 student representatives

Activities of the ICC

In the year 2022-23, ICC stood by its purpose and worked on fulfilling the mission of its existence through sensitization and awareness programs for prevention of sexual harassment at the workplace.

The year brought about the offline working of the institution as well as the ICC. The campus reopened for all the students and staff. ICC members remained abreast to make sure that campus remains a safe place for every individual, this year we began with a motive to build a sensitized community of young people and encouraged the students to join ICC in the volunteering capacity. The volunteers were enriched with the understanding about the grave concern of "sexual harassment at workplace", the purpose of ICC at workplace, and their role of creating further awareness in their classrooms, peer groups and campus as a whole.

Regular meetings were convened with the student representatives of the ICC to chalk out the events for the year; follow-up meetings were held to see the flawless implementation of the plans.

The year 2022-23 witnessed the active engagement of student volunteers in competitions as well as off-campus workshops for virtual sensitization and awareness programmes for prevention of sexual harassment at workplace with active involvement of the ICC student representatives. ICC continued to make its presence felt on social media platforms like Instagram and Facebook. The social media handles were created to spread awareness and reach to maximum number of Irwinites, and be easily approachable to them. The representatives along with the volunteers, under the guidance of the Chairperson, managed the social media page and posted information about sexual harassment at workplace, the role, purpose and functions of ICC and other information regarding the engagement activities conducted by the ICC. A combination of posts,

posters, interactive stories and reels were created to spread awareness and sensitize people in an easy and comprehensive manner.

ICC collaborated with all the 14 (student-headed) cultural societies and other members of the Students' Association of the college to make people aware about the purpose and presence of ICC in the campus and workplace as a whole. All the 14 societies, a core part of the Students' Association passed on the word that they "stand against sexual harassment at workplace" as a unified whole. This year, ICC observed the Discrimination against women Pakhwada from 25th November – 10th December 2022, which began with a "Graffiti Poster Writing" activity to earmark the International Day for Elimination of Violence against Women on 25 November 2022. As part of the activities, an online competition was organized with the theme "Break the Shackles of Silence" on the topic of sexual harassment at workplace in November- December 2022, wherein the students, teaching and non-teaching staff from the college were encouraged to participate and share their thoughts on the given topic through slogan and poster making; it was a successful event as students, teaching and non-teaching staff participated with a lot of enthusiasm; however, the student examination curtailed the participation of the students and staff owing to their time constraints. To acknowledge the efforts and admirable work of all the winners as well as participants, certificates were awarded. Certificates were also given to the volunteers for their contribution in spreading awareness about the ICC.

The ICC representatives and volunteers also attended a workshop on Women Safety organised by SLAP (Street Level Awareness Program) in March 2023 at the American Centre, New Delhi with the aim of raising awareness regarding crime against women, and providing practical guidance and safety tips to the attendees to prevent the cases of sexual harassment.

The ICC had a great year generating awareness regarding ICC and its activities with a team of dedicated student representatives and volunteers.






