**Phase II** Interviews for admission to PhD course in Home Science for the session 2024-2025 will be held on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2025, by the office of the Head department of Home Science, Lady Irwin College.

All candidates who have registered on the portal for Phase II admissions in April/ May 2025 and have cleared any one of the following, may appear for interview:

- Cleared UGC-NET (including JRF) /UGC CSIR NET (including JRF)/ DBT- JRF, ICMR- JRF, DST INSPIRE or equivalent national level examination/ fellowship.
- FOR PHASE II, scores of NET Examination conducted in June 2024 and December 2024 will be considered.

  Candidates who have registered in Phase I, and are also eligible for admissions in Phase II MUST apply in Phase II.

### Details of Instructions for Candidates appearing for interview

- 1. Reporting Time
  - All candidates must report strictly by **8.30 am** to ensure timely document verification on the respective date of their scheduled interviews.

## 2. Area of specialisation for Candidates

- The Candidate shall provide her/his interest for any one of the following Sub-disciplines for interview for admission to Ph.D programme.
  - Food & Nutrition & Food Technology
  - Human Development & Childhood Studies
  - Development Communication & Extension
  - Resource Management & Design Application
  - Fabric & Apparel Science
- Candidates appearing for interview must submit a copy of their research proposal.
- Please bring a valid ID proof (such as driving License, Aadhar Card, PAN card, etc.) that has your photograph at the time of interview.
- The final selection of Candidates is based on eligibility, interview, and availability of seats; consent of the supervisor and in accordance with the University rules.
- The admission of selected candidates is subject to fulfilment of the eligibility conditions and verification of her/his documents after declaration of result of the interview, availability of seats; consent of the supervisor and in accordance with the University rules.
- The Department /University reserve the right to change the number of Fellowships or not award any Fellowship /Ph.D. positions.
- All other relevant rules and regulation of University on this matter are applicable.

#### 3. Documents required

Student may be asked to display any documents (in original) which applicants should have readily available. Candidates must also submit a hard copy of the following photocopies of documents in the office of the Head department of Home Science:

- All degrees, mark sheets, certificates, etc. for essential eligibility condition (in original and a self-attested Photocopy)
- Proof of the claim of the benefit under any category- original certificates.
- Proof of claim for category of Ph.D. application as per revised ordinance VI-B
- No objection Certificate from the employees (if relevant)
- Caste certificate. OBC caste should be as per central list and a certificate of non-creamy layer issued on/after 1st April. 2022.
- Any other relevant documents

### 4. Any additional items for Interview.

• It is advisable to have available, Copy of Masters' dissertation/ training report /work experience/ research paper published, etc for displaying to the committee.
