2.6 Computer Resource Centre (CRC) Staff Salaries

The two junior staff working in the Computer Resource Centre namely Ms. Kusum Kaushik and Mr. Suraj Sunuwar were appointed for a period of one year w.e.f. 01.01.2020 on a monthly consolidated salary of Rs.20,000/- and their appointment term expired on 31st December 2020. They requested vide letter dated 28th December, 2020 for renewal of their appointment.

The staff is needed for laptop issue, hardware status in college and works under STA (computer). These are the only three people working in Computer Resource Centre of the College.

"It was decided by the Governing Body to extend their appointment for one year period from 04.01.2021 (Monday) at Rs.21000/- per month consolidated salary."

2.7 NAAC Core Committee meeting regarding Website

The NAAC core committee in a meeting which took place on 8th December, 2020 approved the name White Code, Advanced Package for website preparation (i.e. Module 3 for Rs.1,52,000/- plus tax), as it includes all the features covered as per NAAC requirements. Copy of resolution is enclosed as an annexure with the agenda.

The members were informed that several website committee meetings were held and tenders compared for technical features and costs.

"The Governing Body recommended updating of old website to meet NAAC requirements of data and noted the procedure followed."

2.8 Ministry of Food Processing/State Food Technology proposal by Dr. Manisha Sabharwal

Under PM formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PM FME Scheme) the Delhi State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation (DSIIDC) has been nominated as State Nodal Agency (SNA) for Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

GNCTD has appointed one State Level Technical Institution (SLTI), Lady Irwin College for capacity building and providing technical input to the Government on PM FME Scheme. Master trainers from College have completed one week training on 17th November, 2020 (Dr. Aparna Agarwal, Ms. Anjana Kumari, Dr. Memthoi, Dr. Nidhi Jaiswal, Dr. Neha Bakshi were nominated). College helped conceptualizing 'One District One Product' (ODOP) in each district under PMFME Scheme. Technical support was provided for ODOP for Delhi State. Representatives of Lady Irwin College (Food Technology Department) are members of State Level Approval Committee. The Nodal Officer from College is Dr. Manisha Sabharwal (Department Incharge, Department of Food & Nutrition and Food Technology) and Dr. Aparna Agarwal, Department of Food Technology.

Now vide letter dated 21.01.2021 they communicated minutes of 1st meeting of State Level Approval Committee held on 12.01.2021. Therein they have recorded a proposal of setting up Incubation Centre at Lady Irwin College. The College representative shared reservations for setting up the incubation centre is also recorded. They still have requested to set up the Incubation Centre and are requesting to segregate the main College from this facility by way of providing a separate entry (minutes of Agenda 4). We should send an immediate reply as per GB decision.

"After detailed deliberations, the Governing Body approved the participation of L_{ady} Irwin College for technical inputs to PM FME. They approved Dr. Manisha Sabharwal and Dr. Aparna Agarwal to represent the College. They did not approve commercial activity by providing separate entry. They recommended that full proposal should be sent officially to College as website information was scanty."

2.9 Status of RAK Child Study Centre

- 2.9.1 This is continuation with last GB held on 5th October, 2020. All contractual RAK staff has finished their term and discontinued. The Mali Samarbahadur retired in November 2020. The Ayah and teachers continue and report daily. The teachers are reporting daily from 01.02.2021 and continue online classes of three children. Only three children are enrolled for online interactions. Only one office staff from Chase is giving office support but from December 1, 2020 is also reporting in Admn. Department of College. He was of great help during CAG audit.
- 2.9.2 Dr. Punya Pillai, Lecturer-in-charge of RAK Child Study Centre has informed vide letter dated 15.02.2021 that they are getting new enquiries for admission and for this she has sought the guidance of advisory committee for opening up new admissions for online/offline classes.

"It was decided by the Governing Body that budget of Rs. 50.00 lakhs per annum is required. If we get 50 admissions by March only then we can start the centre. Further explore if the faculty writes proposals and generate funds and take research credits at RAK is integral to their academic program. Faculty should encourage donor especially alumni to revive the centre, if possible.

Only six months online program should be floated with same Rs.6500/month tuition fee. The centre may consider opening as per NCT guidelines on pandemic for junior schools. If onsite, the fee will be corrected and restored to previous fee structure. Day Care Program and after school till 15 years of age can be offered as usual on usual fee in accordance with pandemic guidelines."

2.10 On retirement of Ms. Yashoda Devi (Security Guard), was on compassional appointment, there is now a possibility of filling one post on compassionate grounds.

The Governing Body was requested to advice on the matter and accord approval submission to UGC for sanctioning compassionate filling on one post

"It was decided by the Governing Body to make a three membered committee of the College who will verify (i) seniority list as per government rules, (ii) verify contents forms to be submitted to UGC. The members comprised one non-teaching

representative on GB, two teacher representatives on GB, one person from College branch like Joint Registrar (Colleges) or his nominee to screen papers."

Extension of tenure of Hostel Superintendent 2.11

Ms. Sunita Srivastava, Hostel Superintendent has requested for extension of her services vide letter dated 07.12.2020. In the last GB meeting on 5th October, 2020 the Hostel Superintendent was given extension till 31st December, 2020. The students have not cleared their baggage. They continue to occupy room and request Hostel Superintendent for permission to open hostel. Some have paid online fees. Many have not taken clearances and refund due. The Hostel Clerk is due to retire in couple of months.

"The Governing Body approved the extension of term of Ms. Sunita Srivastava as Hostel Superintendent w.e.f. 04.01.2021 till 31.12.2021 after giving annual increase of Rs. 1000/-, on a consolidated salary of Rs. 26,000/- per month, keeping the other terms & conditions of her appointment same, as contained in her initial appointment letter dated 23rd December, 2009.

Professor-Principal 2.12

The Assistant Registrar (Colleges), University of Delhi sent a letter dated 28.12.2020 informing that the Principals appointed as per the procedure/process outlined for the selection of a permanent Principal, in accordance with the Ordinance XVIII Clause 7(2)(a) shall be designated as Professor-Principal. EC resolution in this regard is enclosed with the letter.

The Governing Body was requested to accord approval to Dr. Anupa Siddhu, Principal appointed in September 2004 to be designated as Professor-Principal.

"In accordance with communication received from the DU, the Governing Body accorded approval to Dr. Anupa Siddhu to be designated as Professor-Principal as per DU letter dated 28.12.2020."

FINANCIAL MATTERS III.

CAG Audit Report dated 28.12.2020

The CAG audit took place from 14th December, 2020 to 28th December, 2020. Their report was tabled. A reply to their observations has been sent with documentary evidence.

"After going through the CAG audit report, the Governing Body approved the observations sent by the College on 10.02.2020."

3.3 Internal Auditor

The Internal Auditor Mr. Kapur left in 2018. There is a need of Internal Auditor for regular monitoring of accounts work. The CAG auditor made a noting of this matter in their memos (but not in final report). The Governing Body was requested to advice and accord approval to advertise.

3.4 Preparation of Financial Accounts

Kapil V. Aggarwal & Associates were given a letter to support preparation of Financial Accounts of Financial Year 2020-2021. They have done this work for two years in past

They have recommended that unsettled project money awarded to College or its faculty without any transaction in last 5 years and with no demand from funder may be transferred to General Purpose Fund.

"It was decided by the Governing Body that next audit to be expedited by same auditors as their performance is satisfactory. For unsettled project money awarded to College or its faculty without any transaction in last 10 years with no demand from funder may be transferred to General Purpose Fund."
